
SEVERE STORM PREPAREDNESS



All workers should prioritize storm safety during hurricane season by staying informed through reliable weather updates. Regularly check forecasts and sign up for alerts. Before severe weather hits, secure the jobsite by properly storing tools, equipment, and materials. Ensure scaffolding, temporary structures, and loose items are securely fastened. Familiarize yourself with CWC's Safety Storm Plan and follow all safety protocols to protect both workers and the jobsite from potential hazards.

HAMPSTEAD K-8 SCHOOL

The new Pender County K-8 school is our second collaboration with Bordeaux Construction Company, involving a comprehensive 42.1 acre turn-key project with a three year timeline. The scope of work includes multiple phases: mass earthmoving of 225,000 cubic yards of import material, construction of a 22 foot high surcharge with subsequent disbursement and placement, installation of underground utilities and storm drains, as well as curb, sidewalk, and paving work.
