

We're nearing completion of rail installation inside the production buildings, marking a key milestone in this transformative project. Our team is installing all internal rail lines within the plant and constructing the external rail yard and surrounding connections, ensuring seamless integration with Siemens' operations. This state-of-the-art facility will manufacture passenger rail coaches and provide maintenance services, incorporating technologies like robotic welding and 3D printing. Once fully operational, it's expected to be carbon neutral and will create more than 500 jobs by 2028.
