CWC May Project Highlight – Live Oak Pond

As you may know, we have nearly completed Building 4 of the Live Oak Campus on Tiburon Drive in Wilmington. We have now begun a new project to extend the existing pond to allow for future construction of additional buildings. There is a four-month timeline to complete the pond project, which includes erosion control, clearing and grubbing, heavy grading, storm drain systems, seeding, soil stabilization and testing, dewatering of existing ponds, and installing a new building pad.

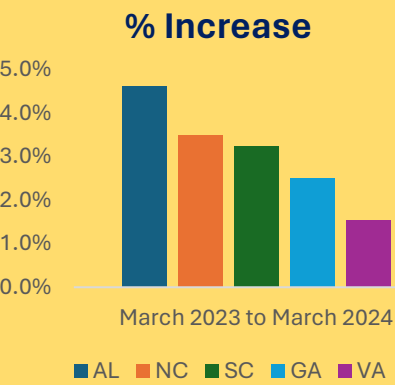

Our offices will be closed Monday, May 27th in observance of the holiday.

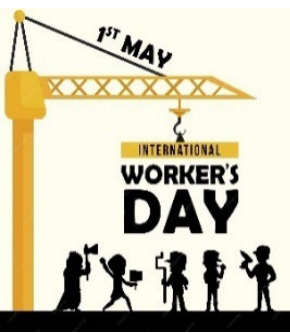
